With your help

Receiving regular donations is the cornerstone of our fundraising activities. We simply could not continue to do what we do without people like you in our community committing to making a regular donation.

Our day-to-day running costs are ever increasing and this makes it more and more challenging for us to purchase the essential medical equipment needed to care for our patients. For example, a syringe driver delivering much needed pain relief costs us £1,100 and the protective cover costs £120. A specialist air flow mattress, which helps to reduce the risk of pressure ulcers, will cost us £3,458.
